**ANNOUNCEMENT
AND
RESUMPTION OF TRADING**

The board of directors of Advanced Semiconductor Manufacturing Corporation Limited announces that an electric power halt which occurred at 10:10 am on Saturday, 27 October 2007 has resulted in serious damages to certain equipment and wafers in fabrication and interruption to wafer supplies at the Company.

Trading in the shares of the Company has been suspended at the request of the Company with effect from 9:30 a.m. on Monday, 29 October 2007. Application has been made to the Stock Exchange for resumption in trading of the shares of the Company with effect from 9:30 a.m. on Wednesday, 31 October 2007.

This announcement is made pursuant to Rule 13.09 of the Rules Governing the Listing of Securities on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited (the "Stock Exchange").

The board of directors of Advanced Semiconductor Manufacturing Corporation Limited (the "Company") announces that one of the public 220KV transformer stations in Shanghai broke down at 10:10 am on Saturday, 27 October 2007 and resulted in a two hour power halt affecting a large part of the Shanghai municipality where the Company is located. The accident caused interruptions to the public transportation system and businesses alike. The accident, which cut off the Company's normal and backup power supplies at the same time and lasted much longer than the Company's uninterrupted power system could support, has resulted in serious damages to certain equipment and wafers in fabrication at the Company and interruption to wafer supplies at the Company's 5- and 6-inch fabrication facility and, to a lesser extent, 8-inch fabrication facility. Fortunately, however, there was no casualty or personal injury during this accident.

Following the accident, the Company has immediately launched an emergency management process to repair or replace the damaged equipment and recover wafer supplies. Whilst the Company expects that subject to customary exceptions and exclusions, a significant portion of its losses will be claimable against the property all risks insurance and business interruption insurance it has taken out, this accident will have some adverse impact on the Company's operation and hence its results for the three

months ending 31 December 2007.

The Company needs to negotiate further with the insurers in order to ascertain the final claimable amounts, which could be different from the above expectation. Presently, the board of directors is not in a position to assess the exact financial impact of this accident on the Company and its consequential damages on operations, but will discuss it in the preliminary results announcement and the annual report for the year ending 31 December 2007. The Company will make a further announcement to inform its shareholders of any major development should it arise and constitute price-sensitive information under Rule 13.09. **Shareholders and potential investors of the Company are advised to exercise caution when dealing in the shares of the Company.**

Trading in the shares of the Company has been suspended at the request of the Company with effect from 9:30 a.m. on Monday, 29 October 2007 pending the release of this announcement. Application has been made to the Stock Exchange for resumption in trading of the shares of the Company with effect from 9:30 a.m. on Wednesday, 31 October 2007.
